

The <u>DeMolay International HQ</u> is located just down the road from the hotel.

<u>TWA Museum</u> is open Wednesday to Saturday from 10am to 4 pm. Tickets range from \$8 to \$12, however it is free for all active military with ID.

Harry S Truman Library is located approximately 30 minutes away from the hotel and has been remodeled recently.

<u>The Roasterie Coffee plant</u> is located approximately 22 minutes away from the hotel and offers tours for \$5. 
